 - d) Quality research papers will be considered for the publication in reputed journals.
- 3. Registration Fee for the international conference is **INR 500.**
- 4. Certificate of participation would be given to the delegates who attend all sessions of the conference and present their research papers.
- 5. No TA/DA will be provided to the participants.
